Article 15.2 – Protest Fees Deposits

15.2 Protest ~~Fees~~ Deposits

- The protest **fee deposit**: €1000
- If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of a clearly defined part of the car, an additional deposit of €2000 must be this deposit must be paid in cash within one hour to the organiser, otherwise the protest will be deemed inadmissible.
- The expenses incurred by the work and by the transport of the car shall be borne by the claimant if the protest is unfounded, or by the competitor against whom the protest is lodged if it is upheld.

If the protest is unfounded, and the expenses incurred by the protest are higher than the amount of the deposit, the difference shall be borne by the claimant. Conversely if the expenses are less, the difference shall be returned to them
